

AHC21020 Cert II in Conservation and Ecosystem Management

This qualification provides an occupational outcome in conservation and ecosystem management. You would be working under general guidance and supervision. You are able to select and develop basic factual, technical and procedural knowledge in conservation and ecosystem management for Indigenous land management, lands, conservation earthworks, lands, parks and wildlife services and the restoration and rehabilitation of ecosystems. Each area may be a job focus or a mix of the above. A total of **15 units** must be completed consisting of **2 core** units and **13 elective** units. The electives may be chosen, according to the cohort of learners and delivery requirements, as per the example below.

Core units:

- AHCWHS201 Participate in workplace health and safety processes
- AHCWRK209 Participate in environmentally sustainable work practices

Elective Units:

- AHCWRK202 Observe environmental work practices
- AHCWRK203 Operate in isolated and remote situations

- HLTAID005 Provide first aid in remote situations

- AHCMOM201 Operate tractors
- AHCMOM203 Operate basic machinery and equipment
- AHCWRK207 Collect and record production data
- AHCWRK208 Provide information on products and services
